Originally from Leicestershire and now a key member of the South East London jazz scene, Nye Banfield is an ambitious jazz saxophonist and composer. He combines his distinctive and raw approach to the music with inspiration from classic 60s Blue Note recordings as well as drawing on aspects of hip-hop and classical music, creating an honest and intense contemporary sound. Nye released his debut EP 'All Change' in October 2018 featuring Dylan Jones of Ezra Collective, and has recently recorded his first album due to be released in the Spring 2022, which features Mark Kavuma and Rupert Cox.

Nye's group create a gripping live experience not to be missed.
